A show of hands

In the ever-evolving (or devolving, depending on how you look at it) world of plastic surgery, we've heard of butt implants, thigh implants and Gore-Tex lips. But butt fat injected into hands?

This procedure was developed to combat telltale hands – the wrinkled, mottled, bony paws that reveal a woman's age, even though her lifted facial skin is taut as a pot.

New Jersey plastic surgeon **Mokhtar Asaadi**, one of the practitioners of this procedure, harvests fat from a patient's buttocks, abdomen, thighs or elsewhere and reinjects it into the hands. The results last about six months, so unless you're just puffing up your hands for a party, repeated injections are necessary.

The cost? From \$1,500 to \$2,500. So you can't be tight-fisted if you want to flaunt tight fists.
